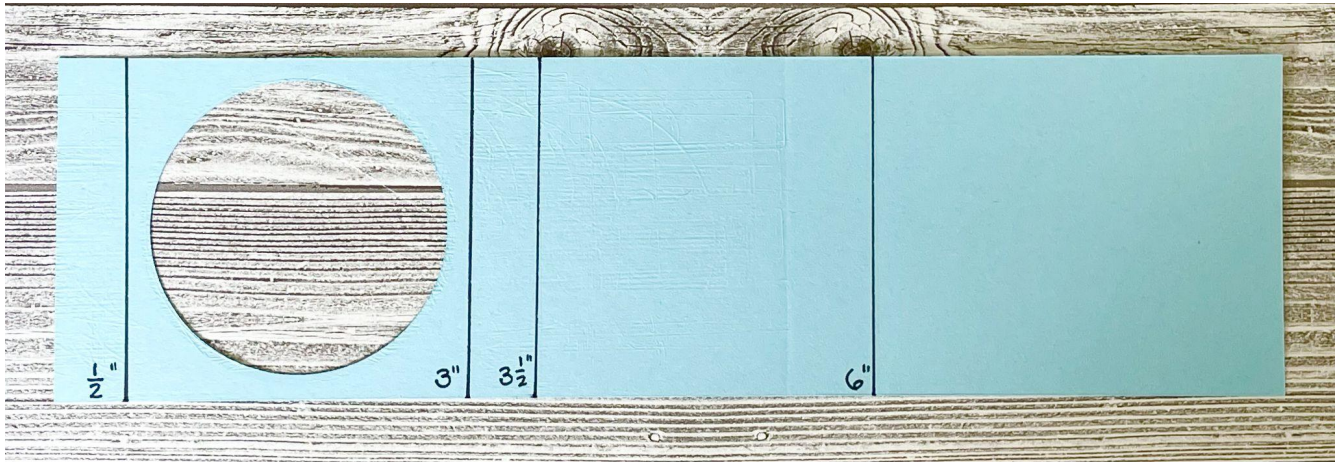
Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Bundle: Friends are Like Seashells Bundle (159516)
- Inks: Early Espresso (147114); Just Jade (153115); Pale Papaya (155670); Sahara Sand (147117); So Saffron(147109)
- Cardstock: Balmy Blue (146982); Basic White (159276); Flirty Flamingo (141416); Just Jade (153079); Pale Papaya (155668); Sahara Sand (121043); So Saffron(105118)
- Designer Paper: Sand & Sea Designer Series Paper (154288)
- Accessories: Linen Thread (104199)

- Tools: Layering Circles Dies (151770); Stitched So Sweetly Dies (151690); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Snips (103579); Paper Trimmer (152392)
- Miscellaneous: Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); (seashell-shaped lip balm)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a 2-1/2" x 9" piece of cardstock for the base. I used Balmy Blue, Flirty Flamingo and Sahara Sand for my bases. Score the base at 1/2", 3", 3-1/2", and 6". Use the Layering Circles Dies to cut a 2/4" circle from the second scored section (see below.)



2. Fold base along all score lines. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere the 1/2" flap to the back of the holder.



3. Cut two pieces of Sand & Sea DSP measuring 2-3/8" x 2-3/8" and 3/8" x 2-3/8". Adhere to the front panels of the holder with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

4. Stamp sentiment on Basic White cardstock with Early Espresso ink; die-cut label with Stitched So Sweetly Dies. Adhere to large panel with Stampin' Dimensionals.

5. Stamp images using coordinating ink and cardstock colors. Die-cut with Seaside Seashells Dies. (You will need to cut out the scallop shell by hand using Paper Snips.) Adhere to holder with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

Seaweed: Just Jade

Scallop shell: Pale Papaya

Sand dollar: Sahara Sand

Starfish: So Saffron

6. Tie Linen Thread into a double knot around the front panel of the holder.

7. Use a Mini Glue Dot to adhere the lip balm inside the circle.
