

Nature's Prints Bay Window Card Fold

Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Natures Prints (158793), Bundle (158801)
- Cardstock: Blackberry Bliss (133675), Basic White (159276)
- Designer Paper: Pretty Prints (159245)
- Ink: Blackberry Bliss (147092), Calypso Coral (122925), Crumb Cake (147116)
- Tools & Accessories: Natural Prints Dies (158800), White ¼" Crinkled Seam Binding Ribbon (151326), Stitched Rectangle Dies (151820), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Blackberry Bliss Cardstock 11" x 4-1/4". Score at ½", 1-1/2", 3-1/4", 4-1/4" and 5-1/2"
- Designer Paper: Pretty Prints Designer Paper pieces (3) 4" x 1", (2) 4" x ¾", (1) 4" x 1-1/2", (1) 4" x 3/8"
- Basic White: 5-1/4" x 4"

Instructions:

- Fold card base on all score lines.
- Set aside one designer paper piece that measures 4" x 1". Glue all others to card front on all scored sections.
- Stamp several different branch images from the stamp set using Blackberry Bliss, Calypso Coral and Crumb Cake Inks as shown in the photo below. Cut with the dies. Glue all but one flat. Glue the stamped branch in the front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Cut (2) non-stamped branches using the dies with Basic White Cardstock. Tuck and glue behind the branch on the front.
- Create a triple bow using the White ¼" Crinkled Seam Binding Ribbon and glue to the bottom of the branches.
- Inside of Card: Glue the Basic White layer to the inside of the card.
- Glue the 1" designer paper layer to the white layer even at the right side.
- Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock using Blackberry Bliss Ink. Cut with the rectangle die that measures 2-3/8" x 1". Glue to the inside of the card even with the right edge using Stampin' Dimensionals. This is the holder piece that keeps the card open.
- Add adhesive to the scored section closest to the center score line on the inside of the card and press flat.
- Place the end of the card under the sentiment layer for the Bay Window shape.
